to equip students with 21st century skills by changing over teaching and learning. Also, systematic lifelong learning is to be developed.

Acknowledge and support multi intelligence and talent development.



Healthy Thais promotion

Promote health literacy, healthy environment and modern healthcare system along with community support.



Ecosystem for human development

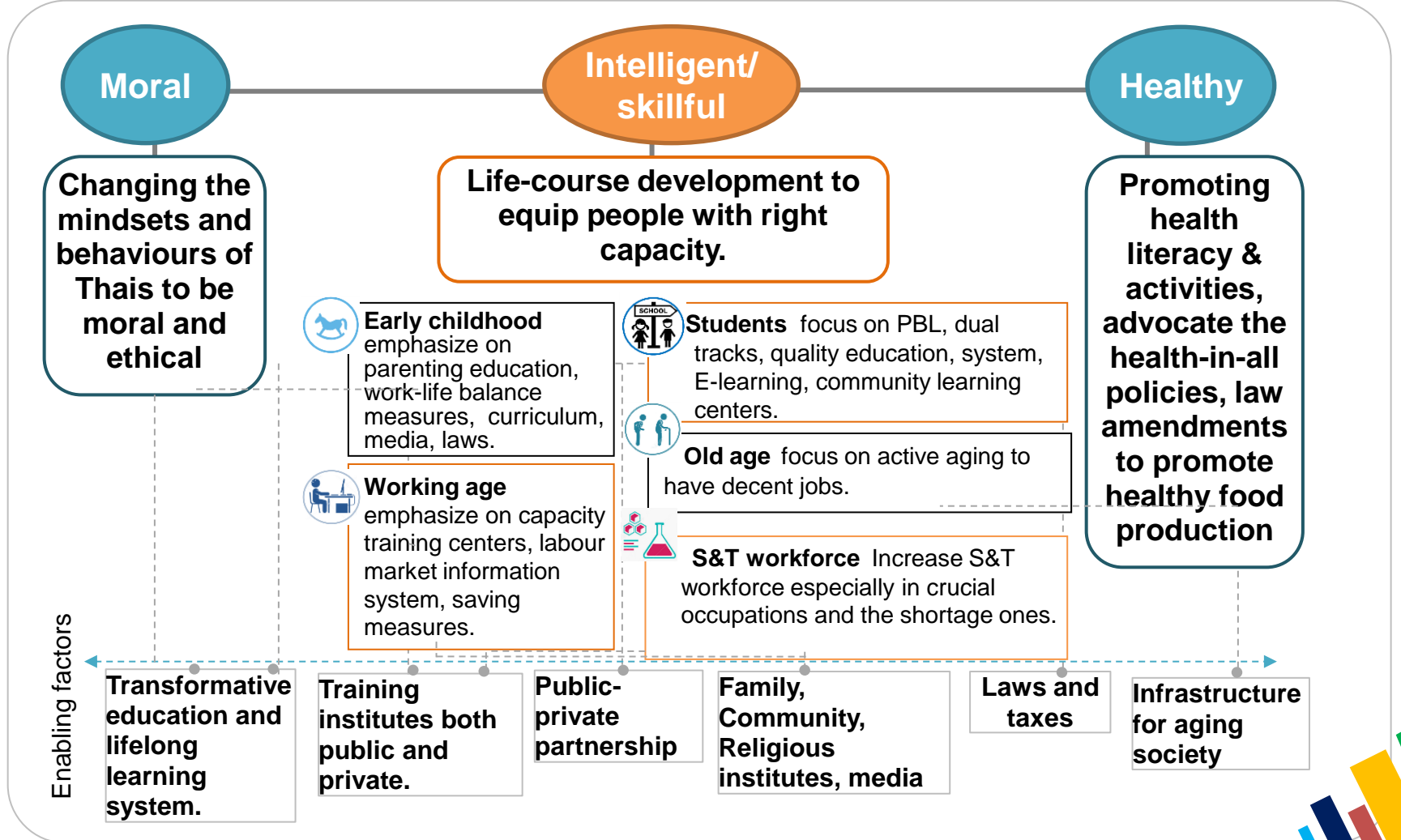
Develop good family, partnership among public-private-family-local authority-community, public spaces for learning and information system.

Pre Primary Education & Early Child Care By 2030, ensure that all girls and boys have access to quality early childhood development, care and pre-primary education

The 20-year National Strategy

- Well-being

The 12th NESDP (examples from the total of 22 indicators)

- Thai people who are aged 13 years and over have more **moral and ethical behavior**.
- There is a proportional **decrease in criminal cases**.
- At least 85 percent of children aged 0-5 years old **develop appropriately** according to their age.
- Increases in **IQ and EQ levels** of school age children and adolescents.
- The number of students enrolling in **Dual Vocational Training (DVT)** increases at an average of 30 percent per year.
- There is an increase in the number of **people certified** by the Thailand Professional Qualification Institution (TPQI) and the number of people passing the National Skill Standard tests.
- There is an increase in the **employment of elderly people** (aged between 60-69 years old).
- **PISA scores** that are not less than 500 for each subject.
- There is an increase in the **use of the Internet for learning** purposes.
- The number of working people requesting the **transfer of their experience** and knowledge as academic credits towards vocational qualifications increases by an average of 20 percent per year.
- There is a decrease in the number of Thai people aged 15-79 years old who are **overweight**.
- The motor **vehicle death rate** is below 18 deaths per 100,000 people.

Key challenges

▶ **The cascade of the national KPIs to actions is quite blurred.**
The goals are big, but currently the evaluation include only the projects using public finance.

▶ **The information system is unintegrated .**

- *The collections are done by each agencies without inter-transfer/ link information together.*
- *The current integration is more or less only bundling projects from each agencies, rather than taking agendas as a starting points.*
- *The beneficiaries' information are not usually recorded and linked with other projects.*
